## **About Us**

NABJ Philadelphia was born out of a need to ensure that Black journalists in Philadelphia maintained the journalistic integrity that had defined their predecessors. On Aug. 24, 2023, a core group of eight Black journalists agreed to form a new local chapter of the National Association of Black Journalists (NABJ). We organized after the leadership of the Philadelphia Association of Black Journalists conflicted with the national organization and became un-affiliated with it. Our founders consisted of long-time officers and members of the local chapter who felt a strong kinship to NABJ and wanted to continue the connection.

On Oct. 27, 2023, the NABJ Board approved NABJ Philadelphia as its only affiliate in the region (#theoneandonly). In our first year, we received the NABJ President's Award in a surprise presentation at the national convention in Chicago in August 2024. It was substantive endorsement of our organization. We amassed a membership of 75 people, including journalists, media professionals, students and friends of the press.

## The Event

This year, NABJ will celebrate its 50th anniversary. Here in Philadelphia, we will honor the local Black journalists who help founded NABJ as well as the founders and early members of the Association of Black Journalists in Philadelphia (ABJ).

This event will explore and commemorate the history of these two great organizations whose members have always sought to present an accurate picture of Black people and their culture, and accentuate the importance of Black journalists in the news industry.

A free local celebration will be held on May 2-3, 2025, at the African American Museum in Philadelphia in the Jack T. Franklin auditorium, named after a prolific Black photographer in the city.

On Friday night May 2, a "Returning to Our Roots" gathering will honor those who came before us, along with a "Looking back to look forward" speech by a nationally named media star, and a photo exhibit of the history of Black journalists in Philadelphia and the community captured by local Black photographers. Our guests will enjoy cocktails, hors d'oeuvres and a live auction of the photographs.

On Saturday May 3, we will hold workshops in the morning to tackle challenges facing the media today and tomorrow.

We are expecting more than 100 guests at the event, including journalists, founders and early members, local dignitaries, community figures, students and others who believe in a diverse media landscape.

With a budget drawn from membership dues and small donations, NABJ Philadelphia has produced meaningful and relevant programming for members, students and the community:

- Training sessions and engaging speakers at our monthly meetings, including Philadelphia Police Commissioner Kevin Bethel, Google training, financial planning, covering violence in a different way, essentials of covering Muslims, rewriting your career. Our meetings are on-site and via Zoom to accommodate all of our members.
- Community forums prior to the November 2024 election: Dissecting Project 2025 and the Black male vote.
- Student conference on how to break into the news industry, held at Temple University.
- Partnership with Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association on an internship to start summer 2025 to place Black students in newspapers around the state.
- Participants in the Acel Moore High School Journalism Workshop at the Philadelphia Inquirer.
- Initiating a mentoring program for the new NABJ student chapter at Penn State University.
- Volunteering for the Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service with Global Citizen, and the Juneteenth Celebration at the African American Museum in Philadelphia.


